## KEOKUK COUNTY BOARD PROCEEDINGS SEPTEMBER 25, 2023

The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Monday, September 25, 2023, in the Board Room of the Courthouse. Present were: Michael C. Hadley, Daryl Wood, Fred Snakenberg and Christy Bates, County Auditor.

Wood moved, Snakenberg seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried. Also present was Casey Jarmes, News-Review.

Snakenberg moved, Wood seconded to approve the minutes of September 18, 2023, as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Met with Engineer McGuire regarding Keokuk County Highway Department happenings as follows: the solar system has been a great savings in secondary roads building utility costs and application was sent for the Dera grant for two (2) tandem axel truck, of which if received will pay 35% of the cost, leaving 65% for county payment.

Wood moved, Snakenberg seconded to approve all eleven mud jacking locations at the estimated amount of 150,000 and two crack sealing locations of Pigeon Road and Hayesville at the estimated amount of 120,000 (+ V67@80,000) that equates in a total of 350,000 to be paid out of the Board's budget. All ayes and motion carried.

Public hearing for resolution and proposal to sell, grant and convey real estate to State of Iowa, regarding project No. STPN-21-1(048)--2J-54, Iowa Highway 21 was held. No oral or written objections were received. Wood moved, Snakenberg seconded to close the public hearing at 9:34 a.m. Motion carried. Action on said item will take place on October 2, 2023.

Hadley moved, Snakenberg seconded to approve ratification of grant application resolution No. 09/2023 for receiving benefits from the Washington County Riverboat Foundation as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Snakenberg moved, Wood seconded to approve both agreements with Matt Welter, General Contractor, for EOC building reconstruction of vehicle damage and ADA compliance and insurance updates as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Various Board and Committee reports was held. Snakenberg participated in an Early Childhood meeting. Hadley attended Semco and Endowment meetings. Wood had no scheduled meetings to attend last week.

Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. Mark Hanson, Dallas County Supervisor, sent an email on behalf of Renodry USA system inviting Keokuk County to a meeting at Louisa County Courthouse in Wapello, Iowa on October 5, 2023 regarding elimination of ground water, salts and building foundation.

On vote and motion Hadley adjourned the meeting at 9:50 a.m.
