

**BOARD MINUTES
SEPTEMBER 27, 2021**

The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Monday, September 27, 2021 in the Board Room of the Courthouse. Present were: Michael C. Hadley, Fred Snakenberg, Daryl Wood and Christy Bates, County Auditor.

8:30 a.m.-Meeting was called to order. Motion was made by Deke Wood to approve the agenda. Fred Snakenberg seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried. Also present was RD Keep.

8:35 a.m.- Review and approval of minutes of previous board meeting was held. Motion was made by Fred Snakenberg to approve the minutes of September 20, 2021 as submitted. Deke Wood seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

8:45 a.m.- Discussion of and possible decision regarding the heating and cooling issues at the EOC Building was held with Larry Smith, EM Coordinator. Larry informed four (4) vendors were contacted, three (3) vendors came to look project over and two (2) vendors submitted bids as follows: Little Construction Inc. - \$12,625 and Rauch Enterprises - \$13,586. An estimate was presented from Markham's Foam, LLC in the amount of \$3,000 for fiberglass insulation and labor. Motion was made by Deke Wood to award the EOC heating, cooling and insulation project to Little Construction- \$12,625 (low bid) and Markham's Foam - \$3000 as submitted. Fred Snakenberg seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried. Larry will contact those awarded the bid.

9:00 a.m.-Approval of quarterly interfund operation transfer from Rural Services Fund (\$429,250), General Basic Fund (\$30,500) & LOST Fund (\$50,000) to Secondary Roads Fund totaling \$509,750 was held. Motion was made by Fred Snakenberg to approve the interfund transfers as submitted. Deke Wood seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

9:05 a.m.-Various board and committee reports were held. Deke Wood attended a 1015 Transit meeting. Fred Snakenberg attended Early Childhood and SADC meetings. Mike Hadley attended Endowment and Rural Housing Trust Fund meetings last week.

9:25 a.m.-Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. Christy Bates distributed the Keokuk County Waste and Recycling Center snow removal ad for review. American Rescue eligible funding use was discussed to be followed up with external inquiry.

There being no further business, motion to adjourn was made by Mike Hadley. All ayes and the meeting adjourned at 9:30 a.m.

The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors adjourned to meet October 4,2021.
