8:55 a.m.-Possible approval of resolution and proposal to sell, grant and convey real estate to State of Iowa, regarding Project No. STPN-021-1-(048)-2J-54, Iowa Highway 21 was held. Motion was made by Deke Wood to approve said resolution as submitted and to authorize the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors to sign on behalf of Keokuk County. Fred Snakenberg seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

9:00 a.m.-Consideration and possible approval of Barn Wired Class C Liquor License and Sunday Sales application was held. Board consensus was to table action due to dram shop not being approved by the insurance company.

9:02 a.m. – Various Board and Committee reports were held. Deke Wood attended a 10-15 Transit meeting. Fred Snakenberg had no meetings to attend. Mike Hadley attended SIEDA, Board of Health, Area XV and Rural Housing Trust Fund meetings.
