8:50 a.m. – Approval of interfund transfer from Local Option Sales Tax (LOST) to the Debt Service fund for the General Obligation Bond interest payment in the amount of \$12,975 was held. Motion was made by Fred Snakenberg to approve the interfund transfer as submitted. Deke Wood seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

8:50 a.m. – Various Board and Committee reports was held. Fred Snakenberg participated in an Iowa Workforce meeting. Neither Deke Wood nor Mike Hadley had scheduled meetings to attend last week.

8:55 a.m.- Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. An email was shared from Design Engineers regarding information on a generator upgrade to accommodate more of the Courthouse in the event of an outage. Board consensus was to gather information to be provided on a spec sheet when put out for bids. HVAC update – the second half of Courthouse transfer/start-up will take place this Wednesday, November 8th.

There being no further business, motion to adjourn was made by Mike Hadley. All ayes and the meeting adjourned at 9:05 a.m.
