

**BOARD MINUTES  
NOVEMBER 10, 2020**

The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Tuesday, November 10, 2020 in the Board Room of the Courthouse. Present were: Michael Berg, Michael C. Hadley, Daryl Wood and Christy Bates, County Auditor.

8:30 a.m.-Meeting was called to order. Motion was made by Mick Berg to approve the agenda. Deke Wood seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

8:31 a.m.-Review and approval of minutes of previous board meeting was held. Motion was made by Deke Wood to approve the minutes of October 26, 2020 as submitted. Mick Berg seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

8:45 a.m.-Review and possible approval of Family Farm Tax Credits for Assessment Year 2020 was held with Drew Sanders, County Assessor/GIS. Drew distributed the list of new owners and individuals that have acquired more land, further noting one application was rejected. Motion was made by Deke Wood to approve said tax credits as submitted. Mick Berg seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

8:50 a.m.-Various board and committee reports were held. Mick Berg attended a Decat meeting. Mike Hadley attended Keswick and Hayesville City Council meetings to discuss waste management and patrolling of law enforcement. Deke Wood had no meetings to attend last week.

8:55 a.m.-Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. Larry Smith, Emergency Management Coordinator, entered on behalf of Allie Helmuth, Public Health Director, regarding possible approval to purchase notebook computers for Public Health telehealth visits. Board consensus was to move forward on the purchase. Christy Bates provided a copy of the Keokuk County Infectious Disease Action Plan COVID-19 Pandemic dated April 6, 2020 for review.

9:00 a.m.-Official canvass of November 3, 2020 Keokuk County General Election was held. Also present were LuAnn Berger, Elections Administrative Designee and Democratic Party designated observers Gary Whittington and Oliver Hidalgo-Wohlieben. Those present proceeded to canvass said election. Official results are attached, no discrepancies were found.

There being no further business, motion to adjourn was made by Mike Hadley. All ayes and the meeting adjourned at 1:30 p.m.
