

KEOKUK COUNTY BOARD PROCEEDINGS
NOVEMBER 10, 2020

The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Tuesday, November 10, 2020 in the Board Room of the Courthouse. Present were: Michael Berg, Michael C. Hadley, Daryl Wood and Christy Bates, County Auditor.

Berg moved, Wood seconded to approve the agenda. All ayes and motion carried.

Wood moved, Berg seconded to approve the minutes of October 26, 2020 as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Wood moved, Berg seconded approval of Family Farm Tax Credits for Assessment Year 2020 as submitted by County Assessor/GIS Sanders. All ayes and motion carried.

Various board and committee reports were held. Berg attended a Decat meeting. Hadley attended Keswick and Hayesville City Council meetings to discuss waste management and patrolling of law enforcement. Wood had no meetings to attend last week.

Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. Emergency Management Coordinator Smith entered on behalf of Public Health Director Helmuth regarding possible approval to purchase notebook computers for Public Health telehealth visits. Board consensus was to move forward on the purchase. Bates provided a copy of the Keokuk County Infectious Disease Action Plan COVID-19 Pandemic dated April 6, 2020 to review.

Official canvass of November 3, 2020 Keokuk County General Election was held. Also present were Elections Administrative Designee Berger and Democratic Party designated observers Gary Whittington and Oliver Hidalgo-Wohlieben. Those present proceeded to canvass said election. No discrepancies were found.

On vote and motion Hadley adjourned the meeting at 1:30 p.m.
