8:30 a.m.-Meeting was called to order. Motion was made by Mick Berg to approve the agenda. Deke Wood seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

8:31 a.m.-Review and approval of minutes of previous board meeting was held. Motion was made by Deke Wood to approve the minutes of November 10, 2020 as submitted. Mick Berg seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.
