The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Monday, November 16, 2020 in the Board Room of the Courthouse. Present were: Michael Berg, Michael C. Hadley, Daryl Wood and Christy Bates, County Auditor.

Berg moved, Wood seconded to approve the agenda. All ayes and motion carried.

Wood moved, Berg seconded to approve the minutes of November 10, 2020 as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Berg moved, Wood seconded to approve the claim listing dated November 16, 2020 as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Wood moved, Berg seconded approval of Personnel Report for Brycen W. Dolan, full-time Deputy, Sheriff's Department, at \$52,286.00 per year effective November 16, 2020 as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Berg moved, Wood seconded approval of recount for Congressional District #2 for the November 3, 2020 General Election as required per Iowa Code 50.48(1)(a). All ayes and motion carried.

Various board and committee reports were held. Berg participated in a Regional Mental Health meeting. Hadley drove to What Cheer to find the city county meeting had been cancelled.

Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. Bates distributed the following for review: Iowa Department of Public Health enhanced measures in effect November 11 through November 30, 2020; application letter stating Keokuk County is applying for CDBG Infectious Disease Response funds to support emergency management response to the coronavirus pandemic in the amount of \$18,477.36 and annual information provided by the librarians within Keokuk County.
