

BOARD MINUTES
APRIL 17, 2023

The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Monday, April 17, 2023 in the Board Room of the Courthouse. Present were: Michael C. Hadley, Fred Snakenberg, Daryl Wood and Christy Bates, County Auditor.

8:30 a.m.- Meeting was called to order. Motion was made by Deke Wood to approve the agenda. Fred Snakenberg seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

8:35 a.m. - Review and approval of minutes of previous board meeting was held. Motion was made by Fred Snakenberg to approve the minutes of April 10, 2023 as submitted. Deke Wood seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried. Also present were Casey Jarmes, News-Review, Tameem Jahan, Apex project developer, and Christine Edmundson Long, Treasurer.

Motion was made by Deke Wood to approve the reports as submitted. Fred Snakenberg seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

9:30 a.m. – Various Board and Committee reports was held. Deke Wood attended the monthly RUSS meeting. Fred Snakenberg attended Mental Health and SEIL meetings. Mike Hadley had no scheduled meetings last week.

9:35 a.m.- Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. Board consensus was to approve Derek Kitzman’s request to continue mowing the EOC/DHS lawn. The HVAC project was discussed regarding boiler demo and disposal of existing AC units.

There being no further business, motion to adjourn was made by Mike Hadley. All ayes and the meeting adjourned at 9:40 a.m.
