Homemaker Service

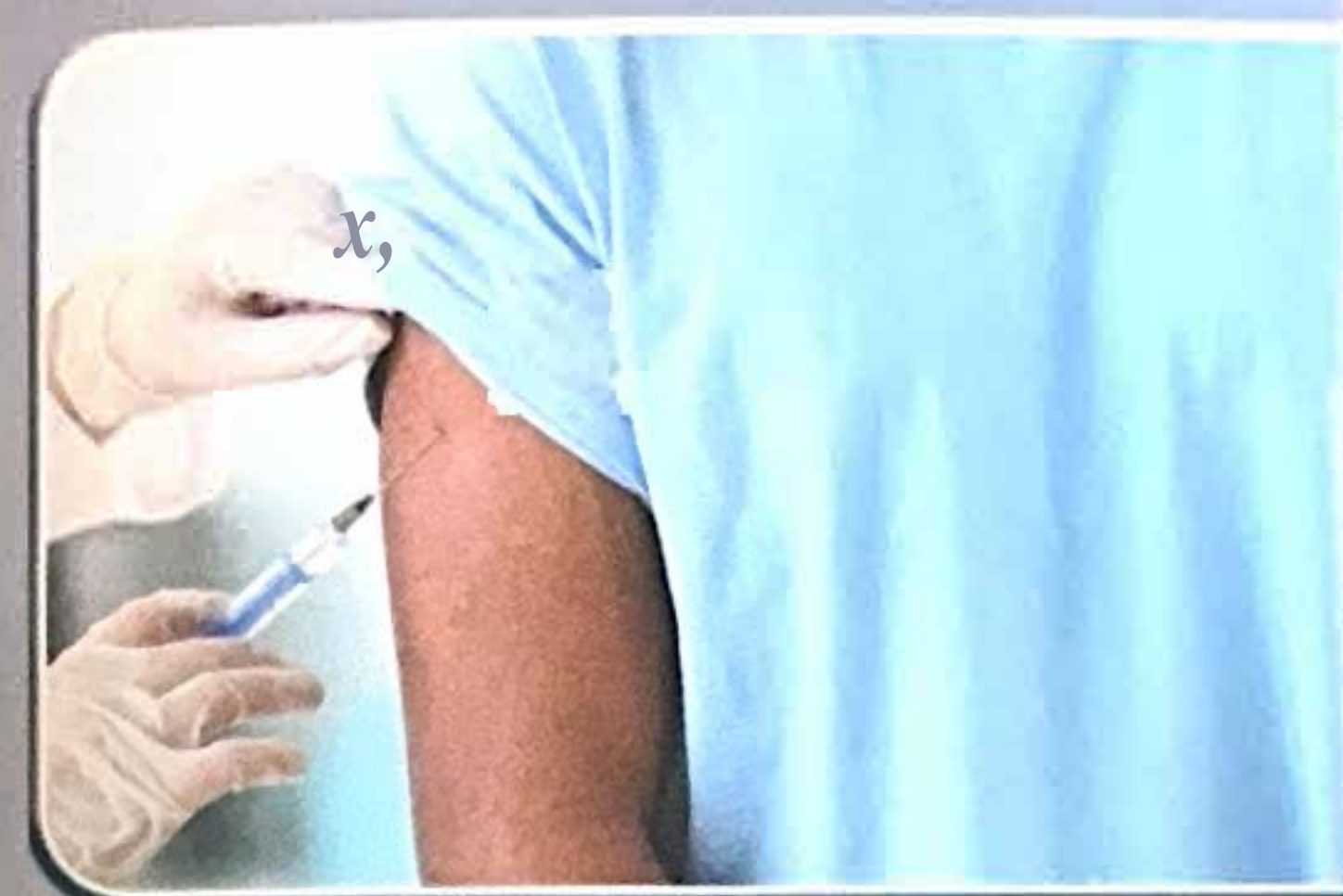
Trained personnel provide assistance with general light housekeeping, errands, meal preparation, grocery shopping, and laundry.
